## Guidelines:

1. Contestants must reside in the State of Kentucky and provide proof of residency upon request.
2. Contestants must have reached their 5th birthday but cannot have reached their 8th birthday by June 30, 2022.
3. The contestant must be a full-time student in an accredited Kentucky School System (this includes homeschool).
4. Pageants will follow all state regulations.
5. All registration forms and birth certificates must be turned into the pageant committee by Sunday, July 24, 2022.
6. Entry fee of \$30 is due on or before July 24, 2022 by 10 pm.
7. We will also have an optional Miss and Mister photogenic (awarded separately) for an additional \$10 entry fee.
8. Private Interview will begin at 6:00 pm with Stage introduction at 7:30.
9. Contestants need to be at the Griffin Center by 5:45 pm on July 28th.
10. Attire: T-shirt (provided by the fair) and Blue Jean Shorts
11. People's Choice Award: Envelopes will be provided for each contestant. \$1 per vote.
12. The winners will be acclaimed and reign as Little Miss and Mister Pendleton County Youth Fair throughout the year and represent the PCYF at the Little Miss and Mister Kentucky County Fair Pageant on August 18, 2022. If unable to fulfill their obligations, the 1st runner-ups may assume the duties as decided by the pageant committee.
13. Winners will be expected to participate in all fair activities throughout the week as requested by committee.
14. Winners will not receive monetary awards until all state paperwork is completed and turned into the fair board.
15. Contestants are encouraged to write Thank You notes to sponsors.
16. There will be no soliciting of donations of any kind towards state competition.
17. NO ONE will be PERMITTED backstage except for pageant committee members.
18. Pageant decisions and changes are made by the pageant committee. ALL COMMITTEE AND JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL. No score cards will be distributed.
19. We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

## Pony Pull

Thursday, July 28 at 7:00PM

Bluegrass Pony and Mule Pulling Association 2022

Classes: 950-1650 Double overweight  
1651-2250 Double overweight

(These classes are to be kept for the pulling seasons 2019 through 2023)

Light side pulls 12 ft between 14 ft ropes

Heavy side pulls 15 ft between 14 ft ropes

## Weights

Weighing will start 6 hours before the pull and end 1 hour before the pull starts. If there are pulls scheduled, we will weigh ponies and mules on Saturday. If you don't miss a pull, weights will carry until the following Saturday. If the first pull of the week is scheduled any day other than Saturday we will weigh that day and the following Saturday unless it is Friday. See the exception below:

## Exception

If no pulls are scheduled until Friday, we will weigh Friday, if you don't miss a pull, the weights carry until the following Saturday. If you miss the weighing pull and weigh mid-week you will still weigh at our next weighing pull no matter the amount of days. Weigh as many times as needed to enter the class. (Not to get an extra block) One man is to hold all ponies to be weighed except his own.

No more than 18 blocks (1 layer) will be added to the lightest team between rounds

No heading

No walking beside the ropes

Judges decision is final

4 people between ropes per team

After command of go is given only ONE driver

3 passes = 1 pull

6 passes = Done

If you take the 2nd hitch, you can't spot the 3rd but you can change directions.

There is no original direction...hook the way the sled is headed

Entry fee is \$20

All fair money will be paid back 1-5 places
