MARKET CLASS- Poultry boiler pens will be issued by Pendleton County 4-H to all eligible members. All Market Classes will be judged on the conditioning of meat in the animals and uniformity. Market Classes will be judged via Danish System (Blue Ribbon, Red Ribbon, White Ribbon). Overall Best of Show and Reserve of Show will receive banners.

Market Class Additional Rules:

*These rules will serve as additional/supplemental rules to the general rules outlined for the 4-H/FFA show rules.

1. All exhibitors must report to the Exhibitor Check-In table prior to entering the show area. Animals must be weighed and marked during this time as well.
2. Pendleton County 4-H/FFA members who are between the ages of 9-18 may elect to sell their project at the Market Show & Sell. Ages 5-8 are ineligible to sell.
3. 4-H/FFA members may enter market class animals in showmanship class.
4. All members must attend 6 hours of educational meetings and be active members of the PC 4-H Poultry Club prior to show. Meeting attendance will be signed off on by Poultry Club leaders.
5. Exhibitor may only sell poultry broiler pen if they are not selling another species at the Market Livestock Sale.
6. Exhibitor is required to fill out and enter a Poultry Record Book at the County Fair during entry day on Sunday, July 17, 2022 to sell that respective species in the Livestock Show and Sale.
7. Exhibitor is required to complete the Skillathon contest that will be set up at the County Fair during entry day on Sunday, July 17, 2022 to participate in the Livestock Show & Sale.
8. Market animals cannot be shown by more than one exhibitor.
9. Each exhibit must be healthy and clean. Any animal showing signs of illness will be removed from the fairgrounds immediately.
10. All exhibitors must present their own birds to the judge. Cloverbud aged members may receive help from the club's President and/or Vice President.
11. Lab coats are encouraged to be worn by exhibitors.
12. Exhibitors will be allotted 5 Cornish Cross chicks from PC 4-H Poultry club after May 1st 2022. A \$10 deposit will be required and returned once the project is completed. Project completion includes raising the chicks, submitting a Poultry Record book, completing the Skillathon, showing the poultry in the market show and at the Show & Sell (if applicable) and dispatching the poultry for the buyers. Deposit will not be returned if all applicable steps are not completed.
13. Market Poultry dispatch day will be Sunday, July 24th. Exhibitors must attend and actively participate in the dispatching process. Any exceptions must be approved by Poultry Club leaders.
14. Meat Pen will be limited to one entry per exhibitor. An entry shall consist of a pen of three birds weighing a minimum of 4 pounds per bird. Poultry not reaching minimum weight will not qualify for Show & Sell.
15. Fryer Class shall consist of one bird and must weigh 3-5lbs. Fryer Class birds are not eligible for Show & Sell. There is no limit of fryer entries per exhibitor.
