Rules

1. All market goats must be born after November 1, 2021.
2. Horns are optional but must be tipped. Tipped is defined as the end of the horn squared off to ½ inch diameter or larger.
3. All goats are required to have a complete unbroken mouth and goat teeth and weigh a minimum of 35 lbs. at the time of the fair. Animals are subject to be mouthed to check age.
4. Market kids must be cleaned and castrated (banded or surgically removed, clamping is not allowed) by annual tag in date and clipped slick above the knee and hock joint.
5. Exhibitors may enter the market wethers or market does. Induced cryptorchids (short scrotum kids). Any wether kid showing signs of secondary sexual characteristics may not be shown.
6. Goats will be shown with a humane type of training collar.
7. Buck goats under 12 months may be shown in breeding class with breed registration papers or KUIP tag.
8. Wether dams will be entered as fitted or slick at the time of show. Wether dams will be shown by weight in their division. Goats shown as wether dams will not be eligible to show as market goats or other breeding class at the show.
9. Breeding classes will include fullblood/purebred does, percentage does and commercial does. Commercial does will be shown by weight. Commercial does may be kids or yearlings and will be determined by teeth at day of the show.
10. Buck goats under 12 months may be shown in breeding with breed registration papers or KUIP tag.
11. Decision on class breaks will be made by the show committee.
12. Breeding animals cannot be entered in a market class, too.
